“The Power of Wellbeing”

Parish and town councils used to have a legal “power of wellbeing” that enabled them to do anything that “promoted the economic, social and environmental wellbeing of their area”. The legal power has been superseded by the General Power of Competence (GPoC) now but for most parish and town councils, promoting community wellbeing is right at the heart of their raison d’etre. This year’s AGM explores the role of parish and town councils in health and wellbeing, whether it is being on the frontline of the community response to the Coronavirus pandemic or providing vital services that reduce loneliness and social isolation.
