

Clerk's Update following meeting held 13<sup>th</sup> July 2020:

Item 6.1

Request for Seat in Cemetery: There have been delays to the delivery of this seat and the company offered to supply a larger model (4-seater, 25cm longer) in order to mitigate further delays. Delivery was expected to be w/c 27<sup>th</sup> July 2020, but this did not happen. Cllrs Fox and Davies are on standby to meet the resident at the Cemetery once the seat has been delivered in order to agree the installation.

Notice on Public Footpath at Croughton Mill: The Notice has been taken down.

Item 10.2.1.2 Mobile VAS, interference of hedges at Blenheim and Portway: The hedge at Portway was reported to Fix My Street on 14<sup>th</sup> July and the call closed after Northants Highways failed to locate the VAS on Lamp 30! Both hedges were subsequently reported to Fix My Street on 17<sup>th</sup> July 2020 and a site meeting with an Officer from Northants Highways will take place on 10<sup>th</sup> August 2020. This will be reported on at the PC Meeting on 10<sup>th</sup> August (Agenda item 10.2.1.2)

Item 10.2.2: Allotments:

Plot 28: Plot 28 was allocated to a new tenant on 16<sup>th</sup> July 2020.

Allotment Wall: Mr Dempsey has been asked to provide a quote to clear vegetation and suckers growing into the wall from the roadside.

Item 10.2.3.1: Cemetery:

The quote for perimeter fencing was accepted on 14<sup>th</sup> July 2020. The Contractor will commence work on 25<sup>th</sup> September 2020.

Item 10.2.5: Defibrillator: The AED Guardian was advised that the Parish Council was satisfied to continue with and support the current monitoring and inspection arrangements carried out by the Guardians but that, should the Guardians recommend the remote kit, the PCC would be prepared to consider this.
